

## MAX Guides Next Lab – Correction to Process

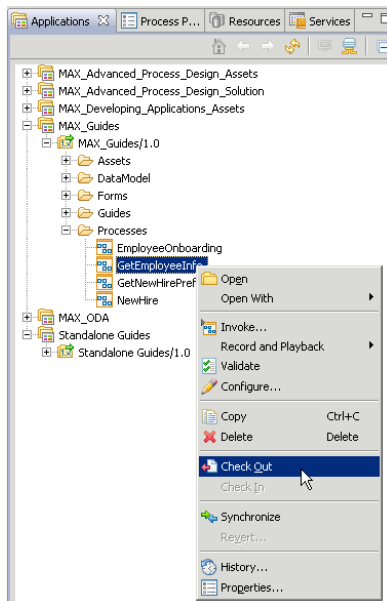
### ***Background***

Some copies of the VMWare image that are being used for the MAX Guides lab may have an error in the “*GetEmployeeInfo*” process. An input parameter is hard coded to the value ‘12345’ instead of using a process variable. This results in the same record always being returned during the search operations.

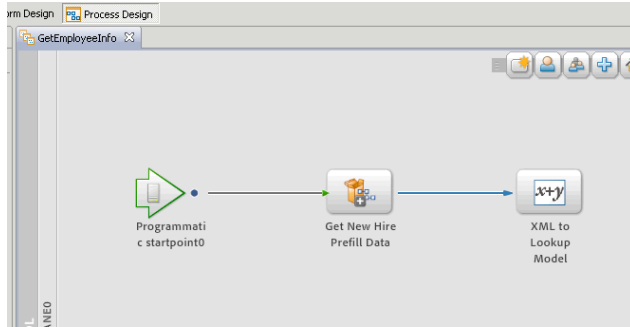
This error has been corrected on the image that will be used by MAX, but participants in the “ES2 Champions” process have been given an image that does have this error. These instructions allow you to verify if your image has the problem, and give detailed steps to correct the image if necessary.

### ***Steps***

1. Open Workbench.
2. Open the Applications view and navigate to ‘***MAX\_Guides > Processes > GetEmployeeInfo***’
3. Check out the ‘***GetEmployeeInfo***’ process.



4. **Open** the ‘***GetEmployeeInfo***’ process. Ensure the Process Design perspective is selected.

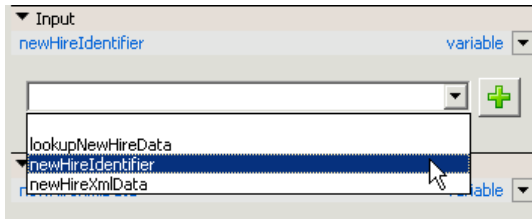


5. Double click "**Get New Hire Prefill Data**". This should open the *Process Properties* view.

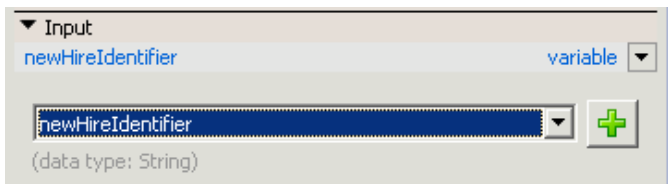
6. Check if the *Input* 'newHireIdentifier' is a literal value of 12345. If so, your image has the error and should be corrected.

7. Change the input type to '**variable**'.

8. Select the '**newHireIdentifier**' variable.



9. The 'newHireIdentifier' input variable should how look like this.



10. **Save** the process, and close the process editor.

11. In the Applications view, right-click on the *MAX\_Guides/1.0* application and select **Deploy** to deploy the process to the server.
