

Changing the visual properties of an object on the client

This example demonstrates how to manipulate the visual properties of an object; in this case, a text field. For example, selecting the check box Make The Field Wider grows the fillable area of the text field to four inches.



To view the calculations and scripts, open this form in Adobe LiveCycle Designer and view the scripting events for each of the check boxes and the Clear All button.

Note: To alter the visual properties of objects on the client, you must save your form as a dynamic PDF.

Instructions

To view a change in a particular object property, select the check boxes below. To remove any effects applied, either deselect the check boxes or click the Clear All button.

Manipulating the object:

- ☐ Move the field
- ☐ Make the field wider
- ☐ Make the field taller
- ☐ Change the border color of the object
- ☐ Change the fill color of the fillable area
- ☐ Expand to fit the width of the value
- ☐ Make the field disappear

Modifying the text field value:

- ☐ Change the font of the value
- ☐ Change the size of the font
- ☐ Align text field value vertically
- ☐ Align text field value horizontally
- ☐ Display a set value

Other:

- ☐ Change the caption text
- ☐ Change field border from 3D to solid
