



Agile Overview

agile vs. Agile

agile: able to move quickly and easily

Agile: relating to or denoting a method of project management, used especially for software development, that is characterized by the division of tasks into short phases of work and frequent reassessment and adaptation of plans

Agile Manifesto

Individuals and interactions over *processes and tools* **Working software** over *comprehensive documentation* **Customer collaboration** over *contract negotiation* **Responding to change** over *following a plan*

That is, while there is *value in the items on the right*, we **value the items on the left more**.

Flavors of Agile

Scrum: Iterative cycles

Kanban: Continuous flow

Extreme Programming (XP): The simplest thing

Lean Development: Ruthless prioritization

Crystal: Interaction and flexibility

Common Ceremonies

 Backlog Grooming: set priorities, clarify expectations, ensure a healthy backlog

Planning: define and document approach

• Stand-up: daily check-in, update plans, identify blockers

• Retrospective: review work and interactions, identify improvements
